



## Parish of St Clément

### PARISH ASSEMBLY

An Assembly of the Principals and Electors of the Parish of St Clement was held at the Parish Hall on Tuesday 1 June 2021 at 7.00pm to: -

1. Consider and recommend to the Licencing Assembly an application by St Clément Sports Club holder of a fifth category (Club) Licence in respect of premises known as The Clubroom, St Clément Football Pitch, La Grande Route de St Clement, to extend the ambit of the licence to include all outside areas.

On opening the meeting Mrs Pearmain requested the Assembly to pause for a moment as a mark of respect for the late Connétable Norman who had sadly passed away earlier that afternoon.

1. On the proposition of Mr Jerry O'Shea and seconded by Mrs Collette Willmett the Assembly unanimously approved the application by St Clément Sports Club to extend the ambit of their fifth category licence to include all outside areas.

In proposing, Mr O'Shea, the President of the Club advised that their facilities were often used for corporate fun days. They were licenced for 100 and with the current covid situation it would be more beneficial for people to be outside rather than in the clubroom. They were currently seeking planning permission to install 3 decked areas which could enable friends and family members to sit outside enjoying a drink whilst supporting a football match.

Deputy Lindsay Ash advised that some months ago, on the invitation of the Sports Club, he and Connétable Norman had visited the premises to be shown what they intended to achieve. It was a tremendous facility which deserved the full support of the Parish.

Deputy Ash was advised that if he wished, he could attend the Licencing Assembly in the Royal Court at 10.00am on Thursday 17 June 2021.
