



Parish of St Clément

Parish Assembly

An Assembly of the Principals and Electors of the Parish of St Clément was held at the Parish Hall on **Tuesday 14 July 2020 at 7.00 pm to:-**

1. Receive, and if deemed advisable, adopt the accounts of the Connétable for the financial year ending 30 April 2020; the said accounts having been previously examined and approved by the Committee appointed for that purpose, and audited by the Parish Accountants, PKF BBA Audit and Assurance Limited.
2. Approve the estimates of the funds required by the Parish for the financial year ending 30 April 2021 to include a sum of money for the upkeep and maintenance of the by-roads and a sum of money for the purpose of making grants to various Charities and Organisations to be allocated by the Connétable and Procureurs du Bien Public.
3. Approve a rate of an amount that will produce for the Parish income that is at least sufficient to satisfy the requirements as set out in the approved estimates.
4. Name a Committee to examine the Connétable's accounts for the financial year ending 30 April 2021.
5. Appoint a firm of auditors to audit the Connétable's accounts for the financial year ending 30 April 2021.


1. On the proposition of Deputy Susie Pinel and seconded by Mrs Sandra Mathew, the Assembly unanimously adopted the accounts of the Connétable for the financial year ending 30 April 2020.
2. On the proposition of Deputy Lindsay Ash and seconded by Mr John Pinel, the Assembly unanimously approved the estimates of the funds required by the Parish for the financial year ending 30 April 2021, a total sum of £855,854. This included the sum £84,800 for the upkeep and maintenance of the by-roads and the sum of £12,000 for the purpose of making grants to various Charities and Organisations to be allocated by the Connétable and Procureurs du Bien Public
3. On the proposition of Mr John Pinel and seconded by Mr Andrew Jelley, the Assembly unanimously approved a rate of .87 pence per quarter.

4. On the proposition of Mrs Phillipa Romeril and seconded by Mr Albert Brown, the Assembly unanimously agreed that the current members of the Committee to examine the Connétable's accounts be re-elected, namely, the two Procureurs du Bien Public, the two Deputies, the Rector, two Churchwardens, the Chef de Police and Mrs Sandra Mathew.
5. On the proposition of Mr John Pinel and seconded by Mr Mark Mathew, the Assembly unanimously agreed that PKF BBA Audit and Assurance Limited be re-appointed to audit the Connétable's accounts for the financial year ending 30 April 2021.

The Connétable mentioned the challenging times the Parish had faced during the Covid-19 situation and expressed his appreciation for the fantastic work undertaken by the Parish Staff, Community Support Team and Honorary Police who had worked tirelessly throughout and indeed continue to do so.

Before the meeting closed, Mrs Sue Pearmain thanked the Connétable for all that he did for the Parish particularly during this stressful time.

The Assembly was attended by 21 Parishioners.
