James Devaney spoke on behalf of LGR Limited advising that the application was in response to requests from their clients to be able to consume alcohol whilst using their facilities. It was their intention to sell bottled beer/cider/wine from a locked fridge behind their customer services desk. Tony Perkins asked what their time they intended to sell alcohol and was advised that the range operated from 8 am to 8pm during the week and 8.30am to 8pm at weekends however the licence would preclude them from selling alcohol that early.

On the proposition of Mr Steven Davison, seconded by Daniel Grigoras, the Assembly unanimously approved the application by LGR Limited for a first category (Taverner's licence) for the Longueville Golf Range.
