Parish Assembly

An Assembly of the Principals and Electors of the Parish of St Clément was held at the Parish Hall on **Tuesday 21 September 2021 at 7.00 pm to: -**


1. Receive, and if deemed advisable, adopt the accounts of the Connétable for the financial year ending 30 April 2021; the said accounts having been previously examined and approved by the Committee appointed for that purpose, and audited by the Parish Accountants, PKF BBA Audit and Assurance Limited.
2. Approve the estimates of the funds required by the Parish for the financial year ending 30 April 2022 to include a sum of money for the upkeep and maintenance of the by-roads and a sum of money for the purpose of making grants to various Charities and Organisations to be allocated by the Connétable and Procureurs du Bien Public.
3. Approve a rate of an amount that will produce for the Parish income that is at least sufficient to satisfy the requirements as set out in the approved estimates.
4. Receive nominations and name a Committee to examine the Connétable's accounts for the financial year ending 30 April 2022.
5. Appoint a firm of auditors to audit the Connétable's accounts for the financial year ending 30 April 2022.

1. On the proposition of Deputy Lindsay Ash and seconded by Mr Chris Le Cornu, the Assembly unanimously adopted the accounts of the Connétable for the financial year ending 30 April 2021.
 2. On the proposition of Mr Alan Le Breton and seconded by Mrs Jill Le Quesne, the Assembly unanimously approved the estimates of the funds required by the Parish for the financial year ending 30 April 2022, a total sum of £906,603. This included the sum £85,800 for the upkeep and maintenance of the by-roads and the sum of £12,000 for the purpose of making grants to various Charities and Organisations to be allocated by the Connétable and Procureurs du Bien Public.
 3. On the proposition of Mr Chris Le Cornu and seconded by Deputy Lindsay Ash, the Assembly unanimously approved a rate of 0.0089 pence per quarter.

4. On the proposition of Rev. Tracy Le Couteur-Bromley and seconded by Mr Neville Falla, the Assembly unanimously agreed that the current members of the Committee to examine the Connétable's accounts be re-elected, namely, the two Procureurs du Bien Public, the two Deputies, the Rector, two Churchwardens, and the Chef de Police. Mr Kevin Romeril proposed that Mr Garry Beardshall should also be elected to the Committee. This was seconded by Mr Chris Le Cornu and unanimously agreed by the Assembly.
5. On the proposition of Mrs Susan Pearmain and seconded by Mr Garry Beardshall, the Assembly unanimously agreed that PKF BBA Audit and Assurance Limited be re-appointed to audit the Connétable's accounts for the financial year ending 30 April 2022.

Connétable Troy acknowledged the challenges that Parish had faced since the sad loss of the late Connétable Norman and paid tribute to Mrs Susan Pearmain, recently retired Procureur du Bien Public and Mrs Beverley Corley, Parish Secretary who had worked tirelessly together with the Parish staff to ensure that Parish services were maintained as efficiently as possible.

The Assembly was attended by 25 Parishioners.
