

Parish Assembly

An Assembly of the Principals and Electors of the Parish of St Clément was held at the Parish Hall on **Thursday 25 August 2022 at 7.00 pm to:-**

- Receive, and if deemed advisable, adopt the accounts of the Connétable for the financial year ending 30 April 2022; the said accounts having been previously examined and approved by the Committee appointed for that purpose, and audited by the Parish Accountants, PKF BBA Audit and Assurance Limited.
- 2. Approve the estimates of the funds required by the Parish for the financial year ending 30 April 2023 to include a sum of money for the upkeep and maintenance of the by-roads and a sum of money for the purpose of making grants to various Charities and Organisations to be allocated by the Connétable and Procureurs du Bien Public.
- 3. Approve a rate of an amount that will produce for the Parish income that is at least sufficient to satisfy the requirements as set out in the approved estimates.
- 4. Receive nominations and name a committee to examine the Connétable's accounts for the financial year ending 30 April 2023.
- 5. Appoint a firm of auditors to audit the Connétable's accounts for the financial year ending 30 April 2023.
- 6. In conformity with Article 5 of the "Loi [1914] sur la Voirie", elect a Roads Inspector for the Vingtaine of Samares to complete a term of office ending 31 December 2023.
- On the proposition of Mr Rob Beaumont and seconded by Mr Chris Le Cornu, the Assembly unanimously adopted the accounts of the Connétable for the financial year ending 30 April 2022.
- 2. On the proposition of Mr Richard Woodhouse and seconded by Mr Alan Le Breton, the Assembly unanimously approved the estimates of the funds required by the Parish for the financial year ending 30 April 2023 a total sum of £1,040,695. This included the sum of £64,749 for the upkeep and maintenance of the by-roads and the sum of £12,000 for the purpose of making grants to various Charities and Organisations as allocated by the Connétable and Procureurs du Bien Public.

- 3. On the proposition of Mr Chris Le Cornu and seconded by Mrs Collette Willmett, the Assembly approved a rate of 0.0101 pence per quarter after which a Parishioner questioned whether the rate could be lowered by taking funds from reserves. Unfortunately, it was explained that he was too late as the rate had already been approved.
- 4. On the proposition of Mr Albert Brown and seconded by Mrs Jill Le Quesne, the Assembly unanimously agreed that the current members of the Committee to examine the Connétable's accounts be re-elected, namely, the Procureurs du Bien Public, the Deputies, the Rector, the Churchwardens, the Chef de Police and Mr Garry Beardshall.
- 5. On the proposition of Mr Glen Hamel and seconded by Mr Simon Wilson, the Assembly unanimously agreed that PKF BBA Audit and Assurance Limited be re-appointed to audit the Connétable's accounts for the financial year ending 30 April 2023.
- 6. In conformity with Article 5 of the "Loi (1914) sue la Voirie" on the proposition of Mr Glen Hamel and seconded by Mrs Collette Wilmett, the Assembly unanimously elected Mr Kevin Leslye Romeril as a Roads Inspector for the vingtaine of Samares, to complete a term of office ending 31 December 2023.

The Assembly was attended by 26 Parishioners.
