- Mr Tony Martin Maindonald was duly elected as a Vingtenier for the Vingtaine of Samares having been proposed by Mr Stephen Walker and seconded by Mrs Anita Allchin.
- 2. Mr Simon Felton addressed the Assembly on behalf of Food Retail Limited, he advised that the Sandpiper Group (the current licensee) are in the process of restructuring their business and this is in effect a transfer of the existing 6th category licence that has been in place for many years. In the interest of business continuity there are no plans to alter anything. The premises will remain the same and it is intended for the manager to continue in their role. The transfer will only take effect once the sale has been completed. No questions were asked and on the proposition of David Le Brocq, seconded by Julie Gallon, the assembly unanimously approved the application by Food Retail Limited for a sixth category (off licence) for Iceland (New Era).
