

## **Parish Assembly**

An Assembly of the Principals and Electors of the Parish of St Clément was held at the Parish Hall on **Tuesday 30 July 2024 at 7.00 pm to: -**

- Receive, and if deemed advisable, adopt the accounts of the Connétable for the financial year ending 30 April 2024; the said accounts having been previously examined and approved by the Committee appointed for that purpose, and audited by the Parish Accountants, PKF BBA Audit and Assurance Limited.
- Approve the estimates of the funds required by the Parish for the financial year ending 30 April 2025 to include a sum of money for the upkeep and maintenance of the byroads and a sum of money for the purpose of making grants to various Charities and Organisations to be allocated by the Connétable and Procureurs du Bien Public.
- Approve a rate of an amount that will produce for the Parish income that is at least sufficient to satisfy the requirements as set out in the approved estimates.
- 4. Receive nominations and name a committee to examine the Connétable's accounts for the financial year ending 30 April 2025.
- Appoint a firm of auditors to audit the Connétable's accounts for the financial year ending 30 April 2025.
- On the proposition of Mr Richard Woodhouse and seconded by Mr Andrew Jelley, the Assembly adopted the accounts of the Connétable for the financial year ending 30 April 2024. On a show of hands, all were in favour with none against.
- 2. On the proposition of Mr Richard Lagadu and seconded by Mr Ken Addison, the Assembly approved the estimates of the funds required by the Parish for the financial year ending 30 April 2025 a total sum of £1,258,585. This included the sum of £113,653 for the upkeep and maintenance of the by-roads and the sum of £12,000 for the purpose of making grants to various Charities and Organisations as allocated by the Connétable and Procureurs du Bien Public. On a show of hands, all were in favour with none against.
- 3. Mrs Marie-Louise Backhurst proposed that the rate should only be increased by the current cost of living (5%) with the shortfall of funds required to satisfy the estimates being taken from reserves. This was seconded by Mr George Gaudin and on a show of hands 4 were in favour with 21 against so the proposition was defeated. On the proposition of Mr Neville Falla and seconded by Mr Michael Robinson, the Assembly approved a rate of 0.0122 pence per quarter. On a show of hands, 21 were in favour with 3 against.
- 4. Mr Albert Brown proposed that Mr Neville Falla be elected to the Committee. This was seconded by Mr Michael Robinson and on a show of hands, all were in favour. Mrs Collette Willimett proposed that the current members of the Committee to examine the Connétable's accounts be re-elected namely, the Procureurs du Bien Public, the Deputies, the Rector, the Churchwardens, the Chef de Police, Mr Garry Beardshall

and Mr Andrew Jelley. This was seconded by Mr Peter Farrell and on a show of hands all were in favour with none against.

 On the proposition of Miss Claire Pulley and seconded by Mr Andrew Jelley, the Assembly unanimously agreed that PKF BBA Audit and Assurance Limited be reappointed to audit the Connétable's accounts for the financial year ending 30 April 2025.

The Connétable thanked the parish staff, all members of the municipality and volunteers for everything they do for the Parish.

Before the meeting closed, Procureur Sandra Mathew thanked Connétable Troy all his hard work.

The Assembly was attended by 30 Principals and Electors.
