Parish Assembly

An Assembly of the Principals and Electors of the Parish of St Clément was held at the Parish Hall on **Thursday 26 August 2025 at 7.00 pm** to: -

1. Receive, and if deemed advisable, adopt the accounts of the Connétable for the financial year ending 30 April 2025; the said accounts having been previously examined and approved by the Committee appointed for that purpose, and audited by the Parish Accountants, PKF BBA Audit and Assurance Limited.
2. Approve the estimates of the funds required by the Parish for the financial year ending 30 April 2026 to include a sum of money for the upkeep and maintenance of the by-roads and a sum of money for the purpose of making grants to various Charities and Organisations to be allocated by the Connétable and Procureurs du Bien Public.
3. Approve a rate of an amount that will produce for the Parish income that is at least sufficient to satisfy the requirements as set out in the approved estimates.
4. Receive nominations and name a committee to examine the Connétable's accounts for the financial year ending 30 April 2026.
5. Appoint a firm of auditors to audit the Connétable's accounts for the financial year ending 30 April 2026.

1. On the proposition of Mr Richard Lagadu and seconded by Deputy Barbara Ward, the Assembly adopted the accounts of the Connétable for the financial year ending 30 April 2025. On a show of hands, all were in favour with none against.
2. On the proposition of Deputy Karen Wilson and seconded by Mr Andrew Jelley, the Assembly approved the estimates of the funds required by the Parish for the financial year ending 30 April 2026 a total sum of £1,334,894. This included the sum of £114,000 for the upkeep and maintenance of the by-roads and the sum of £12,000 for the purpose of making grants to various Charities and Organisations as allocated by the Connétable and Procureurs du Bien Public. On a show of hands, all were in favour with none against.
3. On the proposition of Mr Richard Woodhouse and seconded by Miss Claire Pulley, the Assembly unanimously approved a rate of 0.0126 pence per quarter.
4. Mr Declan Falla proposed that the current members of the Committee to examine the Connétable's accounts be re-elected namely, the Procureurs du Bien Public, the Deputies, the Rector, the Churchwardens, the Chef de Police, Mr Andrew Jelley, Mr Neville Falla and Mr Geoffrey Pirouet. This was seconded by Mr Richard Lagadu and on a show of hands all were in favour with none against.

5. On the proposition of Mr Neville Falla and seconded by Mr Richard Woodhouse, the Assembly unanimously agreed that PKF BBA Audit and Assurance Limited be re-appointed to audit the Connétable's accounts for the financial year ending 30 April 2026.

In closing, the Connétable expressed his thanks to the Assembly for their support. He also conveyed his appreciation for the parish staff, all members of the municipality and volunteers for all that they do for the Parish.

The Assembly was attended by 21 Principals and Electors.
