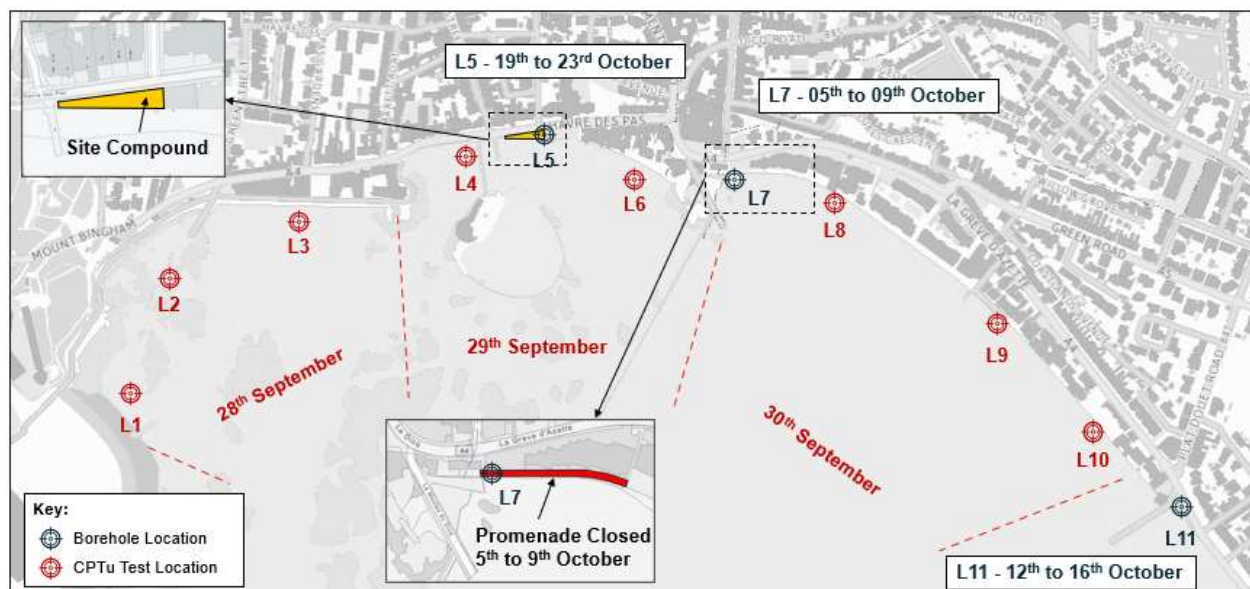

Havre des Pas Coastal Flood Alleviation Scheme – Ground Investigation Works

We are writing to inform you that initial ground investigation works for the Havre des Pas Coastal Flood Alleviation Scheme will begin on 28 September 2026 and continue until 30 October 2026.

The works will involve the use of a mobile drilling rig for the drilling of boreholes to obtain soil samples (L5, L7 & L11) and carrying out CPTu testing on the beach at the other locations. CPTu testing uses a small, tracked rig to push a probe into the ground and measure the properties of the underlying soils. The test locations and approximate dates are shown in the figure below, along with the location of the site compound for the duration of the investigations.



Ground investigation works provide important information about the underlying soils and geology. This information supports the foundation design for the coastal defences, to ensure that are appropriate for local conditions and resilient to future coastal change. To carry out these works, it may be necessary at times to temporarily close individual slipways but notification will be made at the affected slipway when this is happening. The emergency services have been consulted regarding these potential temporary closures.

The beach will remain open to the public throughout the works. However, access to the immediate area in which the contractor is working will be restricted for safety reasons.
